
There are 3!!! new Irish punk fanzines out right now!



Sinéad O'Connor (1966–2023): Premature Anti-Fascist

I found out Sinéad | Shuhada was dead from some stupid engagement-chasing meme account on instagram. I couldn't believe it at first. Then I was sad, then angry for her, then sad again. I wished I was home. I felt sick at heart.

I can't imagine what her family & friends lost. I didn't know the real, flawed, human being who seemed to disappear under piles of obituaries. To me, she was: a musical talent - not just a beautiful voice. A remarkable artist, unashamed to be Irish & also unafraid to challege "official" Ireland. A living indictment of the systems of power, punishment & control that dominated in this country, an abuse survivor who refused to stay silent.

It's wrong that Sinéad O'Connor didn't get to live. No one can know all the reasons why but no matter what, it's WRONG. No more martyrs & no more saints.



"Jesus came here to show us that the truth was worth dying for.
Jesus chose to be crucified, a most agonizing death & he shat himself.
Don't let anybody say he wasn't afraid. He sweated blood. But he did that rather than say that what he was saying wasn't the truth. I believe that, & that's what I took from religion, was that Jesus came to show me that the truth was worth fucking dying for."
